

Mooring Inspection Information

All Old Lyme mooring must be inspected out of the water every four years coinciding with Presidential Election years. A Mooring Inspection Report, signed by an Inspector authorized by the Harbor Master, must be submitted with the Mooring Application and \$25 fee prior to putting the mooring in the water during a Presidential Election year.

Failure to submit the Mooring Inspection Form may result in having the mooring removed under the authority of the Harbor Management Commission. The owner will be liable for the cost of removing the mooring and a fine.

New moorings must be inspected and the Mooring Inspection Form submitted with the application before being placed in the water regardless of the year.

Mooring Permit Applications and Inspection Forms are available on-line at the Town of Old Lyme web site (www.oldlyme-ct.gov) under Harbor Management Commission.
