The OLHD runs from the South Green on McCurdy Road for approximately 1.5 miles down Lyme Street past the North Green to Rose Lane on Route 1. The Old Lyme Historic District Commission strives to preserve the character and history of the OLHD; the Plaque Program aims to authenticate and highlight the historic structures in the District.
