

## Mooring Inspection Information

All Old Lyme moorings must be removed for inspection every four years coinciding with the years of Presidential Elections. A mooring may not be placed back in until a Mooring Inspection Report is submitted with the next year's mooring application and permit fee of \$25. New moorings must be inspected and an inspection form submitted with the permit application regardless of the year.

Inspections must be carried out by a qualified mooring Inspector who has been authorized by the Harbor Management Commission and Harbormaster.

The HMC may remove moorings not pulled from the water during the winter preceding a mooring inspection year. The owner will be liable for the cost of pulling the mooring and subject to a fine of \$70.

Mooring Permit Applications and Inspection Forms are available on-line at the Town of Old Lyme web site ([oldlyme-ct.gov](http://oldlyme-ct.gov)) under Harbor Management Commission.
