

REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS

For Construction Inspection and Testing Services in Town of Old Lyme for
Construction Roadway and Sidewalk Improvements

The Town of Old Lyme is seeking Statements of Qualification from consulting engineering firms to provide construction inspection and testing services for Connecticut Department of Transportation Project 104-172, known as Route 156 Bike Way and Sound View Improvements.

For this project, the consultant shall provide construction inspection and testing services that span the construction project activities from pre-contract award through final close out. The consultant must provide evidence of experience and knowledge in engineering and design drawings/specifications, federally funded projects, construction of roadway and sidewalk improvements following the latest version of Conn DOT's Construction Engineering and Inspection Information Pamphlet for Consulting Engineers.

Sealed statements, clearly marked "Qualifications for Construction Inspection and Testing Services - ConnDOT Project 104-172" will be accepted at the Selectman's Office, Memorial Town Hall, 52 Lyme Street, Old Lyme, CT 06371 until 2 pm, April 4, 2016. Responses received after this date and time will not be considered. The Town will not accept faxed submissions. Responses must include include four (4) printed copies and one (1) digital copy. A Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) goal has not yet been assigned to this project. The selected firm must meet all municipal, state and federal affirmative action and equal employment opportunity practices. The Town reserves the right to reject any and all statements, or parts thereof, which are not in the best interest of the Town of Old Lyme.
