Facilities

No recent major facility problems have been noted as of late.

Cross Lane Park

Cross Lane Park is in daily operation with Little League Baseball and softball, pickleball, tennis and basketball.

Town Woods Park

Town Woods Park is open and in use by the Lacrosse Club, the Lyme/Old Lyme Soccer Club, Lyme/Old Lyme Little League and various AAU softball teams.

Hains Park

Hains Park facilities (no P&R Staff) are open and available to residents. Rowing club activities are active daily.

White Sand Beach

Beach facilities (no P&R Staff) are open and available to residents. Swim lines and the lifeguard chair have been removed. The beach cleaning schedule ends this month.

OLD BUSINESS

August 18 PRC presentation to BOS

Bob Dunn and Sara van Vliet reported on the August 18 BOS meeting that they attended and presented on the dredging of Rogers Lake and goose mitigation. The BOS had suggestions about moving forward and they proposed funding requests over two to three years as a capital project in the PRC budget. A survey of the lake was suggested along with an environmental study, and Sara will contact the RLA to see if they have a recent survey.

Goose mitigation at Hains Park / replace de-coyotes, goose scram application

Bob Dunn reported that a second application of goose scram was applied and that it did reduce the numbers of geese, but once it rained it no longer was effective. Members felt that between the egg addling, the scram and the de-coyotes the geese problem is lessening.

Hains Park playscape update

The playscape has been ordered and hopefully could be installed by late Fall.

Hains Park picnic tables update

Sara van Vliet stated that the picnic tables will be ordered soon, to be delivered to Public Works for assembly and placement at Hains Park.

Hains Park beach cleanings update

Don Bugbee reported that Public Works does not have the proper equipment to rake and clean the beaches. Don will ask the present contractor the Town uses to clean the beaches about adding Hains Park to the contract, and Missy Garvin will ask her husband, who provides this service at Hawks Nest Beach, for input on cleaning Hains Park beach.

New pavilion at White Sand Beach, proposed cost numbers

Don Bugbee stated the new pavilion is Erik Olsen's project and he is waiting for the final drawing. \$175,000 was originally budgeted, but recent changes to the sub-structure brings the estimate to \$139,000. It is hoped that the new pavilion will be done in the Spring of 2026.
