- Call to Order and Welcome
- In attendance: Cheryl Poirier, Jim Lampos, Michaelle Pearson, Mark Terwilliger. Both Allie Lang and Christine McGregor are excused absences.
- Approval of October 27, 2025 Meeting Minutes
 - Motion made by Michaelle
 - Seconded by Jim
 - Vote: unanimous in favor
- Public Comment: Two members of the public from East Lyme attended our meeting. They shared their interest in the book *Revolution in the Lymes*.
- National/State/Regional Efforts:
 - Michaelle reported that Sail Forth will not visibly go past the CT shoreline when heading to Boston from New York.
 - Michaelle also reported that the regional historical society archivists are refining their ideas for the America 250 celebration.
 - OL Historical Society: Will have an exhibit opening in the beginning of March. It will comprise of three glass cases showcasing materials from past celebrations 1776, 1876, and 1976.
