Summary: Hiking this month was a pleasure. Lots of vegetation trimming as growth was starting to encroach on the trails especially on Bartholomew. As requested, I cut back the blue entrance trail and weed wacked the tall grass to the loop. **All trails were open at the end of the month and in good shape.**

5 & 27 June	Hiked Bartholomew. Water level down so bridges are able to be accessed. Widened trail to loop. Trail open.
13 June	Hiked Champlain North. Trails open.
14 & 26 June	Hiked Champlain South. Cut down leaner tree on orange trail. Lots of trail trimming. Trails Open.
15 & 20 June	Hiked Ames. Some trail trimming. All trails open.
