

MINUTES OF MAY 19, 2025

ANNUAL TOWN BUDGET MEETING


An unprecedent amount of townspeople attended the Town of Old Lyme Annual Town Budget Meeting on Monday, May 19, 2025, at 7:30 p.m. in the Meeting Hall of the Memorial Town Hall, 52 Lyme Street, Old Lyme, Connecticut.

First Selectwoman Martha Shoemaker called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. and then called upon Fire Marshal Dave Roberge to address the room capacity of the Meeting Hall and Meeting Hall Lobby. Fire Marshal Dave announced that there were one hundred (100) people in the Meeting Hall, there were twenty-four (24) people in the Meeting Hall Lobby and twenty-five to forty (25-40) people waiting in line. Fire Marshal Dave then recommended finding a new venue for the meeting to accommodate all the voters.

At the advice of Fire Marshal Dave's recommendation, First Selectwoman Martha Shoemaker called the meeting to a close so that it could be moved to a larger venue at a later date and time (to be determined) so that it would allow all voters to hear what they want to hear and to vote.

Selectwoman Jude Read made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Selectman Jim Lampos seconded it. The meeting was adjourned. at 7:35 p.m.
