

## Summary of Rogers Lake Spring Rowing Activities

### Early Spring (April, May, early June) 2022

1. **Blood Street Sculls masters rowing**, most weekday mornings 6 am – 8 am and 7 am to 9 am on Saturday and Sunday. Small number of masters rowers also Tuesday and Thursday evenings, 6 -8 pm.
2. **USRowing National Learn to Row Day** is held the first Saturday of June each year. This year it will be June 5, from 10 AM – 1 PM. On this day we expect approximately 60 people who are new to rowing to come to the Boathouse. Our volunteers will introduce them to the sport with on land demonstrations, a tour of the boathouse, and limited, mentored rowing near the docks. The appropriate forms will be completed and submitted to the Parks and Recreation Commission.
3. **Lyme-Old Lyme HS is coordinated through the LOLHS Athletic Director and HS varsity coaches.** Appropriate forms and schedules were posted by the School. LOLHS typically practices after school. Permits have been submitted to the DEEP for all regattas planned for Roger's Lake. The 2022 regatta schedule is below:
